An exciting and challenging leadership opportunity exists at a comprehensive technical college located in a rural, developing area of South Carolina. The college serves Bamberg, Barnwell, and Allendale Counties. The campus stands on 53 beautifully landscaped acres of land conveniently located about 50 miles south of Columbia, 85 miles northeast of Charleston, and 50 miles east of Augusta, Georgia.

The Presidential Search Committee for Denmark Technical College in Denmark, S.C., one of sixteen colleges in the South Carolina Technical College System, invites applications and nominations for the position of President, the chief executive officer of the college. Denmark Technical College is a full-time residential campus. Denmark Technical College offers accessible, quality higher educational opportunities to citizens within the service area through off-campus sites and evening college in Bamberg, Barnwell and Allendale counties. The college offers 30 programs leading to an associate degree, diploma, or certificate in the technical/occupational disciplines. The Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees, transferable to baccalaureate programs, are also offered. The Fall 2017 student enrollment was approximately 532. Denmark Technical College is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Three (3) academic programs hold national accreditation: Early Care and Education Associate Degree by the National Association for the Education of Young Children; Electromechanical Engineering Technology Associate Degree by the Accrediting Board for Engineering Technology; and General Business Associate Degree by the Association of Collegiate Business Schools and Programs. The College employs a full-time faculty and staff of 70 employees and 56 part-time employees.

- A master's degree is required; an earned doctorate preferred; and
- Ten (10) years of progressively responsible experiences in postsecondary education and/or senior-level administration.
