

FALL ENROLLMENT AND FTE TRENDS ACROSS 10 YEARS






Fall Enrollment and FTE continues to decrease, returning back to pre-recession enrollment levels (Fall 2007)

Data Highlights – Enrollment




- First-Time Freshman, First-Time
 Transfer, and Readmitted Students
 have slightly increased across the years
- Continuing students, our largest student population continues to decrease
- In the non-degree seeking enrollment, high school students have the largest increase from 5,857 students in the Fall 2012 to 8,597 in the Fall 2016
- A total of 45.8% increase across a 5-Year fall enrollment trend for high school students




Data Highlights – Distance Education





A Year in Review: The Best of 2016

Placement Testing

- Secured ACCUPLACER as placement system for all 16 colleges
- Offered four training sessions to administrators and testing coordinators
- Created draft proposal for system-wide cut scores (currently used as guide for colleges that did not pilot)
- Ongoing discussion and evaluation

AdvanceSC: Curricula Enhancements in Metal Fabrication, CNC, & Chemical Operations











- TCTC developed the curriculum for an academic certificate in Metal Fabrication
- GTC, TCTC, YTC reported a total of 80 credentials earned through the National Institute of Metalworking Skills (NIMS)
- SCC developed 163 performance objectives for Process Technology alignment with Chemical Processing Technology (for credit)
- Colleges expended \$192,520 on equipment enhancement

Carl D. Perkins Grant

- Continued Support for Innovative CTE Programming
- Hosted National Expert in Nontraditional Student Populations
- Managed Carryover Funding to Support Additional CTE Activities

NACA Research Grant

- Awarded \$500 from the National Association of Campus Activities (NACA) for research on student activities in the community college

- Data currently being analyzed







- Partnered with the SC Department of Motor Vehicles to implement the license waiver for students who complete the BRC
- Made inventory adjustments at several sites and removed older motorcycles
- Submitted active sites/ranges for approval on the new BRC curriculum. Out of the 10 active sites, 8 are approved for the new BRC and 2 are pending approval from MSF.
- Conducted an analysis of the program with the assistance of a consultant



- Planned two (2) Transitional Rider Coach Preparation (TRCP) sessions for the new BRC curriculum; one has been completed and the other will take place in February
- Provided two (2) coaches with registration stipends to attend the MSF International Rider Education Training System (IRETS) conference


